Responsive regulation involves listening to multiple stakeholders and making a deliberative and flexible (responsive) choice from regulatory

The Patient Safety Rule. The Patient Safety Rule, published in the Federal Register on November 21, 2008, effective on January 19, 2009, is codified at 42 C.F.R. Part 3 (73 FR 70732). The Patient Safety Rule implements select provisions of PSQIA. OCR has responsibility for interpreting and implementing the confidentiality protections described in Subpart C and the enforcement provisions described in Subpart D.
